SECTION 3 Hazards Identification

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW: Irritant. Irritating to eyes, respiratory system and skin. Combustible liquid.

PRIMARY ROUTES OF EXPOSURE: Ingestion, inhalation

EYE CONTACT: Causes irritation.

SKIN CONTACT: Causes irritation to skin.

INHALATION: Irritating to mucous membranes and upper respiratory tract.

INGESTION: No Data Found

ACUTE HEALTH EFFECTS: Harmful by ingestion or inhalation. Irritant

CHRONIC HEALTH EFFECTS: No information found.

SECTION 4 First Aid Measures

EYE EXPOSURE: Immediately flush the eyes with copious amounts of water (lukewarm if possible). Assure adequate flushing under eyelids. Seek medical attention.

SKIN EXPOSURE: Wash affected area with water. Remove contaminated clothes if necessary. Seek medical assistance if irritation or redness persists.

INHALATION: Remove victim to fresh air. Closely monitor the victim for signs of respiratory problems, such as difficulty in breathing, coughing, wheezing, or pain. In such cases seek immediate medical assistance. Give oxygen if deemed necessary. If not breathing administer CPR. Get emergency care immediately.

INGESTION: Give 1-2 glasses of water to drink, provided person is conscious. Seek medical assistance immediately. Keep the victim calm. Do not induce vomiting.
