## SECTION 3 Hazards Identification

---

**EMERGENCY OVERVIEW: Harmful Dust. TOXIC** May cause sensitization by inhalation and skin contact and if swallowed. Irritating to eyes, respiratory system and skin. Chromium compounds are suspected human carcinogens.

**PRIMARY ROUTES OF EXPOSURE:** Ingestion, Inhalation, skin absorption.

**EYE CONTACT:** Causes irritation.

**SKIN CONTACT:** Causes irritation to skin. May be harmful if absorbed thru skin.

**INHALATION:** Irritating to mucous membranes and upper respiratory tract.

**INGESTION:** Harmful if swallowed.

**ACUTE HEALTH EFFECTS:** Prolonged or repeated exposure may cause allergic reactions in certain sensitive individuals; dermatitis.

**CHRONIC HEALTH EFFECTS:** No data Found

## SECTION 4 First Aid Measures

---

**EYE EXPOSURE:** Immediately flush the eyes with copious amounts of water (lukewarm if possible) for several minutes. Assure adequate flushing under eyelids. Seek medical attention.

**SKIN EXPOSURE:** Wash affected area with copious amounts soap and water. Remove contaminated clothes if necessary. Seek medical assistance if irritation or redness persists.

**INHALATION:** Remove victim to fresh air. Closely monitor the victim for signs of respiratory problems, such as difficulty in breathing, coughing, wheezing, or pain. In such cases seek immediate medical assistance. Give oxygen if deemed necessary. If not breathing administer CPR. Get emergency care immediately.

**INGESTION:** Seek medical assistance immediately. Keep the victim calm. Do not induce vomiting.
