SECTION 3 Hazards Identification

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW: CAUTION! MAY CAUSE IRRITATION TO SKIN, YES, AND RESPIRATORY TRACT.
PRIMARY ROUTES OF EXPOSURE: Inhalation, ingestion

SECTION 4 First Aid Measures
