SECTION 3 Hazards Identification

EMERGENCY OVERVIEW: Harmful if swallowed. Dust causes irritation to the respiratory tract, skin and eyes.

PRIMARY ROUTES OF EXPOSURE: Contact with skin and eyes. Inhalation of dust.

EYE CONTACT: Causes severe irritation of the eyes.

SKIN CONTACT: Causes irritation and redness.

INHALATION: Causes irritation to nose, throat and respiratory tract.

INGESTION: Harmful if swallowed.

ACUTE HEALTH EFFECTS: May cause burning, tearing, redness and swelling of the eyes. Respiratory symptoms associated with pre-existing lung disease may be aggravated by exposure to this material.

CHRONIC HEALTH EFFECTS: No Data

SECTION 4 First Aid Measures

EYE EXPOSURE: Immediately flush the eyes with copious amounts of water (lukewarm if possible) for several minutes. Assure flushing under eyelids. A victim may need assistance in keeping their eyelids open. Get immediate competent medical attention.

SKIN EXPOSURE: Wash affected area with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothes if necessary. Seek medical assistance if irritation, burns, or redness persist or develop.

INHALATION: Remove victim to fresh air. Closely monitor the victim for signs of respiratory problems, such as difficulty in breathing, coughing, wheezing, or pain. In such cases seek immediate medical assistance. Give oxygen if deemed necessary. If not breathing administer CPR. Get emergency care immediately.

INGESTION: Immediately call a poison center or doctor. . Keep the victim calm.
